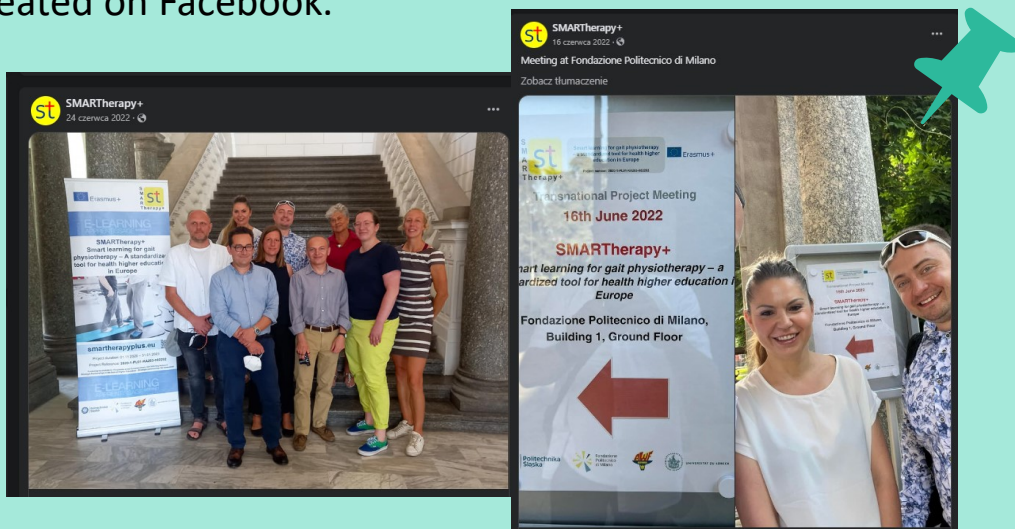


The website is continually updated and updated on the progress of the project. Extension of the project deadline.

The new project finish date is **31.10.2023**.



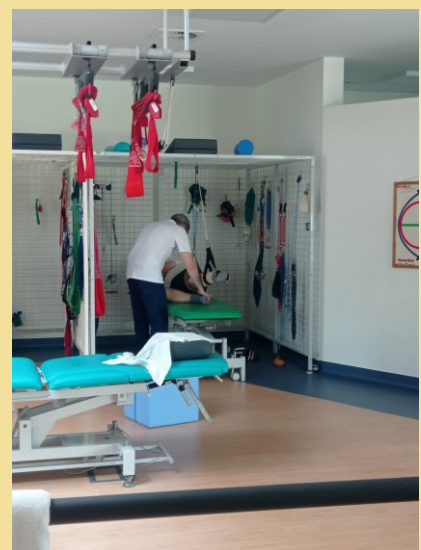
